# JNF TORONTO

The Jewish National Fund is the largest environmental NGO in the Middle East and is the world's central address for building Israel and enhancing the quality of life of all who live there.

JNF's commitment to climate change began when it planted its first tree in 1901. With an organizational mission rooted in afforestation, preserving natural habitats, and safeguarding Israel's water supply, JNF's impact today is only surpassed by its support of transformational social infrastructure programs and projects impacting Israelis throughout the country. This includes victims of domestic abuse, at-risk youth, children with special needs, new immigrants, and individuals living below the poverty line, among others.





Recognizable by his Einstein-like locks, Harley is better known for his 50 years of experience advising on succession, estate, financial and tax planning matters. Concurrently, he formed Minkids Group, a family office dealing with real estate investments and private equity investments in Canadian and international private companies.

Harley has been instrumental in the development of innovative strategies that help transform businesses and prioritize the philanthropic objectives of some of Canada's most prominent families. He has recently become an advisor to Continuum Legacy Partners Inc., specializing in estate and tax planning, including insurance, for ultra-high net worth families.

One of Harley's most notable impacts was in 2015, where he raised more than \$725,000 for the Princess Margaret Cancer Foundation, leading the campaign #NoHairSelfie by shaving off his trademark locks. He has also chaired and/or served on the boards of the Jewish National Fund of Canada, Baycrest Centre Foundation, Starlight Children's Foundation, Canadian Friends of Hebrew University, Holy Blossom Temple Foundation and Reena Foundation among other charities.



# Climate Solutions Prize

This year's Negev Dinner will fund the Climate Solutions Prize, powered by JNF Canada and key partners in Israel, Start-Up Central, Peres Centre for Peace and Innovation, and KKL-JNF. Climate Solutions Prize is an unparalleled prize competition that galvanizes Israel, the start-up nation, to curb the climate crisis. It awards the best and brightest non-profit researchers and/or organizations in Israel to develop breakthrough climate solutions.

The prize of \$1 million USD will be granted to a maximum of four researchers, annually, in recognition of their work on promising solutions to our climate crisis. Proposals will be evaluated by a world-class judging panel and the recipient will be announced during a live ceremony in Israel, which will be broadcast worldwide. The inaugural prize awarded in 2022 went to three university-based researchers.

Many prizes have resulted in major impact developments in the world of science, helping researchers find new and innovative solutions that have helped change the world. The Climate Solutions Prize plans to take this approach and harness the brightest minds to help stop the climate crisis.

Notably, the Climate Solutions Prize also aims to inspire younger generations in Israel and worldwide to be a source of solutions having the power to help repair the world (Tikkun Olam).
