Rebuilding Kibbutz Kissufim

JNF Future is currently supporting JNF Canada's efforts of Rebuilding Kibbutz Kissufim, home to a community of 260 people next to the Gaza border, where 16 members were murdered by Hamas, three kidnapped and dozens were injured.

Residents in Kissufim are experiencing loss, grief, and isolation. To support their recovery, we are rebuilding the playground and daycare centre for their children, and a youth club for their teenagers, so that once the residents return, the community's children will have places to gather, get support and recover from the traumas they experienced.
