

JNF FUTURE: MISSION TO ISRAEL

DRAFT ITINERARY

NOVEMBER 18 – 25, 2024

Day 1: Monday, November 18th

Shalom and welcome to Israel.

Transfer from Ben Gurion Airport to Jerusalem.

Check in at the hotel in Jerusalem.

Welcome to Jerusalem - "Shehecheyanu" Ceremony at JNF Gateway to Ancient Jerusalem with tour including ziplining followed by a tour of the New City of Jerusalem.

Opening session - Understanding the Context: Looking back to October 7th and towards the future with your tour guide.

Welcome dinner at Piccolino Restaurant, Jerusalem, and an opportunity to explore Jerusalem's nightlife.

Overnight: Dan Panorama, Jerusalem

Day 2: Tuesday, November 19th

Breakfast at the hotel.

"Israel Now" Military Briefing: Gain insights into contemporary Israel with an overview of Gaza and key battlefields from the Swords of Iron War by an IDF Spokesperson.

Visit to Mt. Herzl Military Cemetery and ceremony at the Memorial Hall for Israel's Fallen.

Discover the **Old City** of Jerusalem - the stories, traditions, and legends behind the stones in the ancient city with a historical, cultural, and archaeological tour. Walk the Jewish Quarter with it uncovered the Roman Cardo - the marketplace from the Roman era and The Western Wall, where the stones of the Second Temple are exposed. Continue to **Kotel Tunnels** to unveil hidden sections of the Western Wall. Walk through the Arab Bassar to see nowadays Middle Eastern life with its rich colors, flavors, and smells.

Lunchtime Delights: Rub shoulders with locals as you enjoy a delicious Falafel or Shawarma lunch at vibrant street stands.

JNF Project Visit: Explore the innovative developments in medical care at the Glassman Center of Herzog Hospital, including post-October 7th PTSD treatments.



Drive back to the hotel and enjoy a free evening.

Day 3: Wednesday, November 20th

Breakfast at the hotel.

Journey south to **Kissufim** for a unique volunteering experience in agriculture projects and hear from survivors of October 7th. Visit to include participating in the writing of the Fenwick Sefer Torah for Kibbutz Kissufim.

Box Lunch

At the **Nova Festival site**, where party participants brutally murdered in October. 7, and meet with a survivor to hear his firsthand accounts of that fateful day.

Visit to Kibbutz Re'im and meet with Emergency Preparedness Chief, Ilan Cohen, and learn about the heroism of the Re'im security team and the new Sheltered Classroom being built by JNF Canada.

Visit **Sderot**, located on Israel's border with the Gaza Strip and meet with **Mayor Alon Davidi**. See local JNF projects and see first-hand the proximity of Sderot to Gaza from the Gaza Overlook.

Drive back to Jerusalem.

Dinner at local restaurant.

Travel south to **Aleh Negev**, a pioneering rehabilitation village, for a volunteering opportunity.

ADI Negev-Nahalat Eran: Volunteer and explore the innovative social centre, experiencing firsthand the inclusive community model it represents.

Tour of Kibbutz Nir Oz with Elan Isaacson, Security Chief of the Eshkol Region.

Visit one of our Future Donor's project sites in Nir Oz

Drive to Tel Aviv straight to your hotel for check in.

Enjoy a leisurely late afternoon exploring Tel Aviv, taking in its vibrant atmosphere.
