We will also be recognizing The Honourable Shuvaloy Majumdar, MP Calgary Heritage, for his unwavering support of Canadian Jews and Israel.

This is JNF Calgary's most significant fundraiser of the year, with contributions supporting our important work in Israel. This year, with the Israel Magen Fund of Canada, we are supporting the construction of the **Ashdod Rehabilitation and Therapy Center** which will provide critical medical and rehabilitative care to trauma victims, children with disabilities, and pediatric cancer patients in southern Israel.

The center will feature rehabilitation clinics, a hydrotherapy pool, medical facilities, daycare, and educational spaces. Its goal is to offer high-quality care close to home, reducing the need for long travel times, serving hundreds of patients each month. Southern Israel faces a severe shortage of rehabilitation services, exacerbated by the October 7 war. Thirty percent of wounded patients and most of the war victims are from the south, stressing an already overwhelmed healthcare system. With only 11 rehabilitation centers in the south, compared to 43 in central Israel, wait times are often over a year.
