In a world turned upside down in the aftermath of the October 7th, we are fortunate to have powerful forces that have stood up against the overwhelming amount of hatred unleashed against Israel and the Jewish people. This evening's event, "One Nation, One Heart", features the future of the Jewish people – the Lions' and Lioness' that are leading the revolution combatting hate and anti-semitism.

Tonight's guest speakers are the light unto the darkness, Columbia Professor Shai Davidai stood up against the hatred and hypocrisy on campus since the horrific events of Oct. 7th and has been advocating for Jewish Civil rights ever since. Noa Argamani's advocacy has become a source of strength for Klal Yisrael. Recently named one of TIME magazine's most influential people of 2025, she has spoken at the United Nations and in the Oval Office, using these global platforms to raise urgent awareness about the need to bring the hostages home immediately.

JNF Edmonton is joining many other JNF regions across Canada in raising funds to build the Ashdod Rehabilitation and Therapy Centre, which will provide desperately needed service to those wounded in the war and others with serious medical ailments in southern Israel. For this project, the partnership between Israel Magen Fund of Canada and Jewish National Fund of Canada is one of shared goals and love of Israel. Our important work would not be possible without you, our generous donors. After more than 18 months of heartbreak, we are still gathering in support of Jewish peoplehood and celebrating our connection to the land of Israel.

Our Project

Ashdod Rehabilitation & Therapy Centre

A New Center for State-of-the-Art Therapeutics, Rehabilitation, and Education



Southern Israel faces a severe shortage of rehabilitation services, exacerbated by the October 7th war. The Ashdod Rehabilitation and Therapy Center will provide critical medical and rehabilitative care to trauma victims, children with disabilities, and pediatric cancer patients in southern Israel.

The center will feature rehabilitation clinics, a hydrotherapy pool, modern medical equipment, a daycare, and educational spaces. Its goal is to offer high-quality care close to home, reducing the need for long travel times. Located near the Samson Assuta Ashdod University Hospital, it will serve hundreds of patients each month.

Thirty per cent of wounded patients and most of the recent war victims are from the south, stressing an already overwhelmed healthcare system. With only 11 rehabilitation centers in the south, compared to 43 in central Israel, wait times are often over a year. The Ashdod Rehabilitation and Therapy Center will help address these challenges by providing timely, accessible treatment for those in need.

Shai Davidai

Assistant professor of business at Columbia Business School

Shai's research examines people's everyday judgments of themselves, other people, and society as a whole. He studies the psychological forces that shape, distort, and bias people's perceptions of the world and their influence on people's judgments, preferences, and choices.

Shai work has been published in top-tier journals such as the Proceedings of the National Academy of Science, the Journal of Personality and Social Psychology, the Journal of Experimental Psychology, Perspectives on Psychological Sciences, and the Journal of Behavioral Decision Making. His research has been featured on media outlets such as The New York Times, The Guardian, and The New Yorker among other outlets, and podcasts such as Freakonomics Radio and The Atlantic Podcast.

After graduate school, Shai spent a year as a post-doctoral researcher at the School of International and Public Relations at Princeton University and then three years as an Assistant Professor of Psychology at The New School for Social Research.

In 2020, he was listed as a "Rising Star" by the Association for Psychological Science (APS). The aftermath of October 7 on Columbia University's campus prompted Shai to speak out about antisemitism. He was locked out of campus by the administration, yet he continues to be a leading voice against Jew-hatred and anti-Zionism.

He says his biggest achievements to date have been the births of his son Orion, 7, and his daughter Toren, 2.



Noa Argamani

Rescued hostage

Noa Argamani, 27, from Be'er Sheva, a computer science student at Ben Gurion University, was kidnapped along with her partner, Avinatan, on October 7, 2023, during the Nova Festival by Hamas militants and taken into Gaza. Images of her abduction, in which she was seen crying for help, shocked the world and became a symbol of Hamas's brutality. Noa was rescued in a daring operation by security forces in June 2024.

Since her release, Noa has been advocating for the release of the remaining hostages held by Hamas, including her partner, Avinatan. On February 26, 2025, she delivered an emotional and impactful speech before the UN Security Council, urging the international community to act for the release of the hostages.

Social Club in Kibbutz Kissufim

Kibbutz Kissufim, near Gaza, was devastated in the October 7 attack. Sixteen residents were killed, one taken hostage, and critical infrastructure destroyed. Homes, farms, and public buildings were left in ruins. Despite the terror, many residents bravely helped and defended their community. Today, Kissufim is nearly empty, its families displaced, but their spirit remains strong. JNF Canada is supporting the kibbutz's rebuilding, starting with the Social Club—a fortified space for gathering, healing, and restoring community life at the heart of Kissufim.




Gayle TallmanEducational Fitness Park For Children & Youth




